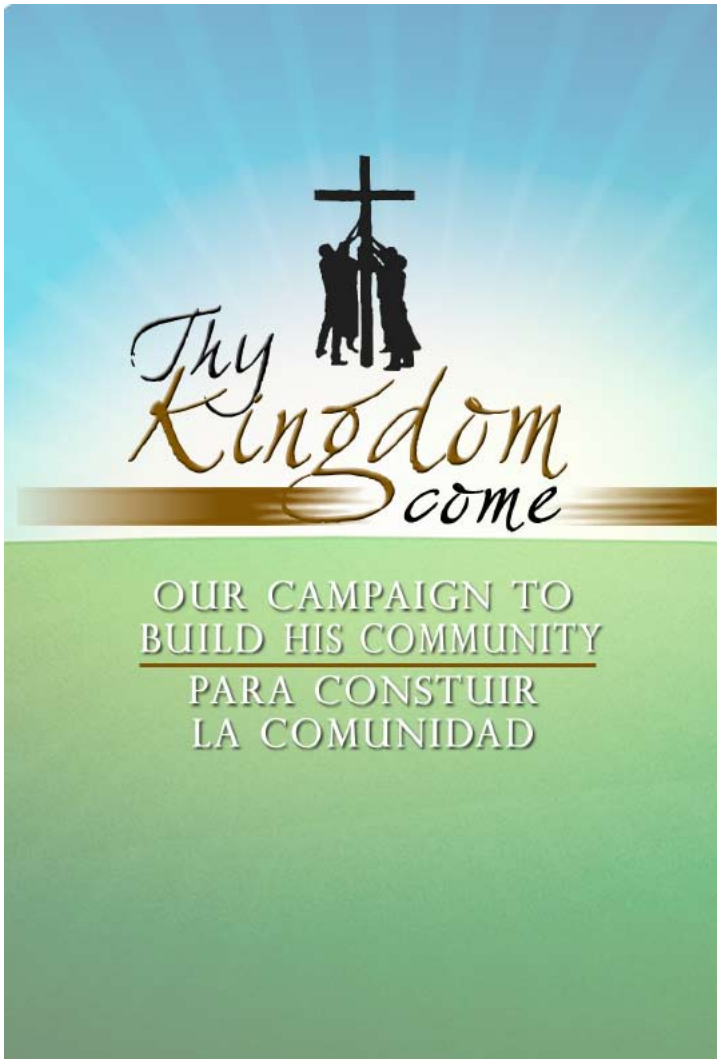

Pope Benedict XVI has voiced his joy that he will beatify his predecessor John Paul II on May 1, after recognizing a miracle attributed to the late Polish pope.

"On the first of May I will have the joy of proclaiming blessed the venerable John Paul II, my beloved predecessor," Benedict said during his weekly Angelus address.

He said the date chosen was very significant because it was the second Sunday in Easter, which the late pontiff Karol Wojtyla, who died on April 2 2005, had dedicated as the Feast of Divine Mercy for the repentance of sins, an article of the Catholic faith.

## APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOOL

Applications for the 2011-2012 school year are now available from the school office. The following must be presented with the application:

Kindergarten and Grade One Applicants:

- Preschool evaluation form (please submit if your child is attending preschool or kindergarten report card)
- Baptismal Certificate
- Immunization Record
- A \$35 application fee for kindergarten and grade one applicants (non-refundable)

Grade Two-Eight Applicants:

- Baptismal Certificate and First Communion Certificate for grades two through eight.
  - Immunization Record
  - Copy of the most recent report cards for grades one through seven.
- In order to keep the file updated, report cards and SAT (test scores) are to be submitted on a quarterly basis.

The number of spaces in all grades except for kindergarten and grade one depend on an end of the year decrease in enrollment. Students presently enrolled in Daniel's Den preschool must complete the kindergarten application process. Those children wishing to enter kindergarten must be five years of age by September 1, 2011. Students wishing to enter grade one must be six years of age by September 1, 2011 (Diocesan Policy).

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

All student receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this Spring must attend one of the retreats in February 4 - 6 or 25 - 27. The fee for the retreat is \$200.

## Archbishop Dolan Calls for Prayers, Greater Respect for Human Life in Wake of Arizona Shooting



WASHINGTON -- (January 10, 2011) The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) renewed their call for respect for human life, as the nation mourned for those affected by the shooting that killed six, including John M. Roll, the chief judge for the United States District Court for Arizona, and wounded at least a dozen others, including U.S. Representative Gabrielle Giffords. The incident occurred on the morning of January 8, when Giffords was meeting with constituents outside a supermarket in Tucson, Arizona.

"Our prayers and concern are with those most immediately affected by this violence," said Archbishop Timothy Dolan of New York, president of the USCCB. "We commend to God those who have died and we pray for the families who

lost loved ones and for those who are suffering from their wounds. We also pray for the person who committed these acts and those who are responsible for his care."

"While we as bishops are also concerned about the wider implications of the Tucson incident, we caution against drawing any hasty conclusions about the motives of the assailant until we know more from law enforcement authorities." Archbishop Dolan said. "Violence of any kind must be condemned. When the target of a violent act is a public official, it shakes the confidence of the nation in its ability to protect its leaders and those who want to participate in the democratic process. As bishops we call once more for respect for the life and dignity of every person as we work together for the common good, seeking to address the various social and political issues that face us as a nation."

## Bishop Cordileone of Oakland (Former Priest and Auxiliary of San Diego) Appointed New Chairman of USCCB Defense of Marriage Committee

WASHINGTON (January 5, 2011) – Archbishop Timothy Dolan, president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), has appointed Bishop Salvatore Cordileone of Oakland, California as chairman of the USCCB Ad Hoc Committee for the Defense of Marriage. Bishop Cordileone succeeds Archbishop Joseph Kurtz of Louisville, Kentucky, who was elected vice president of the USCCB in November 2010.

"I am grateful for the leadership of Archbishop Kurtz and humbled by this opportunity to serve the bishops of the United States, the Church and our country on this most vital and defining issue of our day," Bishop Cordileone said. "Marriage and the family are the essential coordinates for society. How well we as a society protect and promote marriage and the family is the measure of how well we stand for the inviolable dignity and good of every individual in our society, without exception. The consequences for our future – especially that of our nation's children – cannot be greater and must not be ignored."



Bishop Cordileone, a current member of the Ad Hoc Committee, is also a member of the USCCB Committee on Canonical Affairs and Church Governance. In addition to his extensive background in the area of the canonical understanding of marriage, he also brings experience in the work of preserving the definition of marriage as the union of one man and one woman in California.

The Ad Hoc Committee was established by the U.S. bishops in the fall of 2008 with the support of the Knights of Columbus. At the bishops' 2010 Fall General Assembly in Baltimore, Cardinal Francis George of Chicago, then-president of the USCCB, announced that Defense of Marriage would be transitioning into a subcommittee under the bishops' Committee on Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth, which is chaired by Bishop Kevin Rhoades of Fort Wayne-South Bend, Indiana. The transition will occur during the first half of 2011.

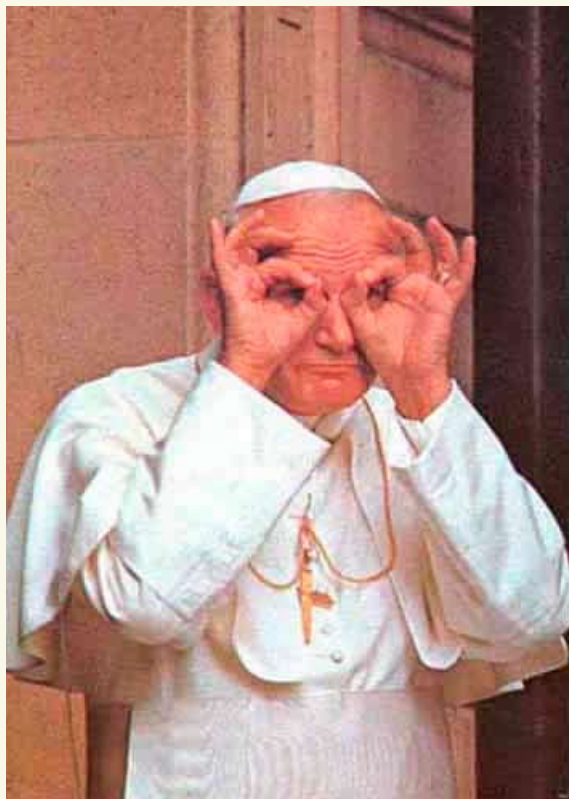

## JUAN PABLO II

La beatificación del Papa polaco, paso previo a la canonización, se llevará a cabo en tiempo récord, inferior a los cinco años habitualmente necesarios para iniciar el proceso. Juan Pablo II falleció el 2 de abril de 2005.

La celeridad se explica por la "imponente reputación de santidad de la que gozó el papa Juan Pablo II durante su vida, en su muerte y después de su muerte", explicó El Vaticano en un comunicado.

La comisión de cardenales y obispos de la Congregación para las Causas de los Santos aprobó esta semana un milagro atribuido a la intercesión de Juan Pablo II, paso clave antes de elevarlo la gloria de los altares. Se trata de la curación "inmediata e inexplicable", en junio del 2005, de la monja francesa Marie Simon-Pierre, quien sufría el mal de Parkinson, que también afectó al jefe de la Iglesia católica, indicó la comisión. La monja, de 50 años, enfermera de profesión, según el postulador se curó tras oraciones y peticiones a Juan Pablo II pocos meses después de la muerte del pontífice.

La canonización requerirá la ratificación de otro milagro.

Juan Pablo II estuvo al frente de la Iglesia católica durante 27 años. Durante su sepelio, sus fieles clamaron: "¡Santo subito!" (¡Santo ya!).

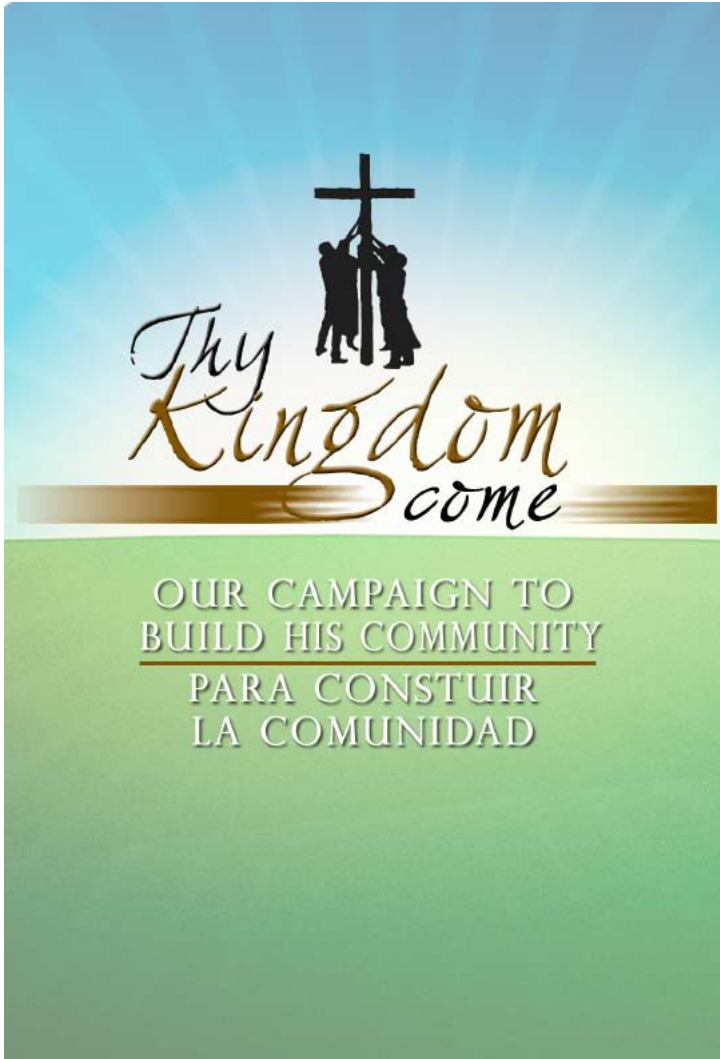
