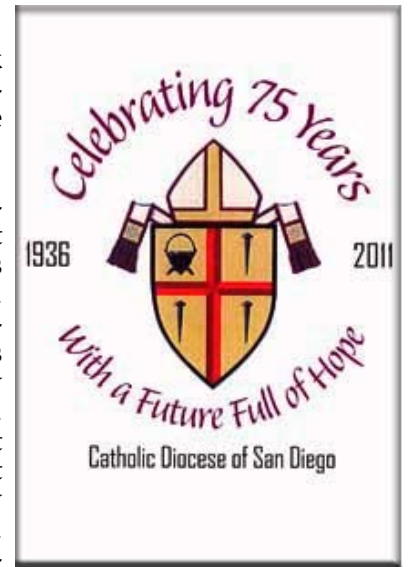
A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

APPLICATION FOR SCHOOL



Applications for the 2011-2012 school year are now available from the school office. The following must be presented with the application:

Kindergarten and Grade One Applicants:

- Preschool evaluation form (please submit if your child is attending preschool or kindergarten report card)

- Baptismal Certificate

- Immunization Record

- A \$35 application fee for kindergarten and grade one applicants (non-refundable)

Grade Two-Eight Applicants:

- Baptismal Certificate and First Communion Certificate for grades two through eight.

- Immunization Record

- Copy of most recent report cards for grades one through seven.

In order to keep the file updated, report cards and SAT (test scores) are to be submitted on a quarterly basis.

The number of spaces in all grades except for kindergarten and grade one depend on an end of the year decrease in enrollment. Students presently enrolled in Daniel's Den preschool must complete the kindergarten application process. Those children wishing to enter kindergarten must be five years of age by September 1, 2011. Students wishing to enter grade one must be six years of age by September 1, 2011 (Diocesan Policy).

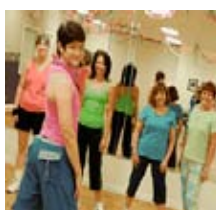
ICF Cooking Demonstration

CHRIST IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD



Our Annual "Christ in Our Neighborhood" program will begin with the First Sunday of Lent. The program is designed primarily for neighbors and friends to gather and reflect on the Sunday readings throughout the Season of Lent. However, families may choose to make this their Lenten practice for the six weeks leading up to Holy Week. If you are too busy to gather with a group, simply use the program for personal reflection.

If you are a leader of a parish ministry, group, or organization, you may wish to call together your group and meet at your home. We urge people to meet at their homes and not at the Church. Christ in our Neighborhood works best in a neighborhood home.

If you were part of a group last year, ask your leader if he/she will be conducting a group again this Lent. If you would like to lead a group, simply gather some of your friends, family members, and neighbors at your home for an hour or so each week for six weeks. If you are interest in leading a group, here is all you need:

1. The Christ in Our Neighborhood material will be found in the parish bulletin for each week. **The first week's edition will be found in next weekend's bulletin.**
2. Set a day/evening prior to the First Sunday of Lent in order to gather your group in your home for an hour (or hour and a half) to reflect on the Sunday's scripture and enjoy some fellowship. You may also choose to reflect on the Sunday's scripture in the week after each Sunday of Lent. Reflecting on the Scripture before or after a Sunday doesn't matter.
3. Before you gather with your group, simply read the two-page reflections in order to prepare for the meeting. In some cases, the Christ in Our Neighborhood instructions will urge the leader to have a small table available on which a cross, bible, or candle can be placed.
4. During the meeting, the leader is asked to simply facilitate the group, making sure that people have an opportunity to answer the week's reflection questions. Try to keep the group to no more than ten people so that you can cover the two-pages in an hour.
5. Having some cookies and coffee or water is nice, but should not be expected.

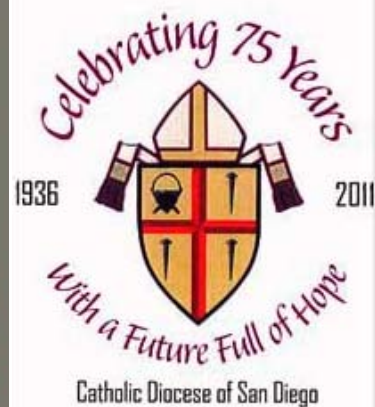
Make the most out of this Lenten Season and become a part of a group to reflect on the Sunday readings. You will be deeply enriched!

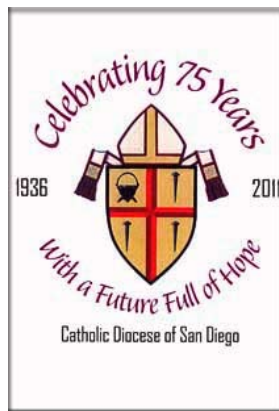

CRISTO EN NUESTRA VECINIDAD



Esta Cuaresma el programa de “Cristo en Nuestra Vecindad” comenzará el Primer Domingo de Cuaresma.

El programa ha sido diseñado primeramente para que vecinos y amistades se reúnan y contemplen las lecturas dominicales durante la temporada de Cuaresma. Pero también, familias pueden utilizarlo durante estas seis semanas como preparación para la Semana Santa. Si ustedes se encuentran demasiados ocupados para reunirse en grupo, entonces simplemente aprovechenlo como una guía personal.

Si usted es un líder de algún grupo de la parroquia u organización, a lo mejor pueden reunirse en sus casas. Queremos que se reúnan en sus casas y no en la Iglesia porque “Cristo en Nuestra Vecindad” funciona mejor así.

Si usted formó parte de un grupo el año pasado, pregúntele a su líder si va a facilitar un grupo ésta Cuaresma. Si usted quiere dirigir un grupo, simplemente junte a su familia, unos amigos, y vecinos en su casa, más o menos por una hora cada semana por las próximas seis semanas. Si quiere facilitar un grupo, ésto es lo que va a necesitar.

1. Este año el material se distribuirá de diferente manera. “Cristo en Nuestra Vecindad” será impreso dentro del boletín de la parroquia. **La primera edición aparecerá en el boletín del siguiente fin de semana.**

2. Antes del Primer Domingo de Cuaresma, ponga la fecha para reunirse en su casa por una hora o una hora y media para contemplar las lecturas y compartir su amistad. Pueden también reunirse después de cada domingo. Realmente no importa si lo hacen antes o después.

3. Antes de reunirse en su grupo, simplemente prepárese leyendo las dos páginas del material. A veces las instrucciones pedirán que el coordinador facilite una mesa adornada con una cruz, biblia o vela.

4. Durante su convivencia, el líder únicamente tiene que facilitar el grupo, permitiendo que cada persona ahí presente pueda compartir su respuesta a las preguntas indicadas de la semana. Traten de mantener el número de participantes a un máximo de diez personas para permitir que el tema del domingo de dos páginas se cubra en una hora.

5. Puede ofrecer café, agua y galletas pero no debe de ser obligatorio.

Sáquele el máximo a esta Temporada de Cuaresma participando en un grupo que contemple las lecturas del domingo. ¡Así podrá enriquecer su vida!
