Third Sunday of Easter

Jesus' gospel message clearly exposes the fallacy that punishment befalls sinners. It is a common idea that when we sin God punishes us proportionally. As a result, the ancient people thought the Galileans who had been killed and desecrated deserved it, because they had sinned. That is not how God works; for more often than not, it is our sins which are the cause of disastrous repercussions. It is the principle of cause and effect. Jesus is explaining that all of us fall short of deserving salvation and the kingdom of God, so we all need to repent to understand the truth of sin and grace. By repenting, we see our lack due to sin, and for the sake of God promote His true goodness in our lives.

From the story of Exodus, God explains to Moses who He is by stating His name as Yahweh, which means: "I am who am", or "I the creating creator," or "I the existing source of existence." Hebrew is a simple language and one word or name has many meanings; however, we still understand that God's name explains who He is. God is the continuing source of the universe's existence.

With this in mind, Jesus proposes a question to us through the parable of the fig tree: After providing us with so many second chances to produce His goodness, would it be prudent of God to no longer sustain our existence?

Tercer Domingo de Pascua

En la versión larga del Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús le pregunta a Pedro tres veces si lo ama y tras cada respuesta de Pedro de que sí lo ama, Jesús le encarga que cuide a Su rebaño de fieles. Desafortunadamente, la versión en inglés no es tan precisa como el texto original en griego que aclara el intercambio entre Jesús y Pedro. En Griego, se usan dos palabras para decir amor: Ágape (avgapa/lj) y Fileo (filw/). Ágape se refiere al amor incondicional que Cristo tiene para su Iglesia, que nos lo ha mostrado con el sacrificio de sí mismo en la cruz y con su resurrección para perdonar nuestros pecados y darnos la vida eterna. Fileo se refiere al amor amistoso, el cariño que uno siente por una mascota, o el cariño por otra persona pero solo hasta el punto que la relación beneficia a ambos.

Jesús le pregunta a Pedro las dos primeras veces si Pedro lo ama en términos de Ágape (amor incondicional), pero Pedro le responde en términos de Fileo (amistad). Finalmente Jesús le pregunta por tercera vez si Pedro lo ama como un amigo (Fileo) y Pedro responde tristemente que sí, solo como amigo, reconociendo que no puede cumplir con las expectativas de su Maestro como cuando negó a Jesús tres veces antes de que cantara el gallo. Pedro todavía tenía mucho que aprender acerca de la verdad, la luz de Cristo, y como comprometerse a ella; por eso Jesús le da a Pedro el encargo de dirigir Su Iglesia. Es en hacer el trabajo del Señor en donde Pedro va a aprender como amar con amor Ágape, como Dios ama.

Nosotros tenemos que aprender como calentarnos con el verdadero fuego del Señor y amar de una manera abnegada. Si optamos ser necios como Pedro y no aprender de la Palabra de Dios, entonces Cristo nos hará trabajar. Si no escuchamos y no nos comprometemos, no encontraremos paz ni realización en nuestras vidas, sino solo el anhelo constante y la llamada de Dios de conformarnos a nuestro propósito para realizar nuestro potencial.

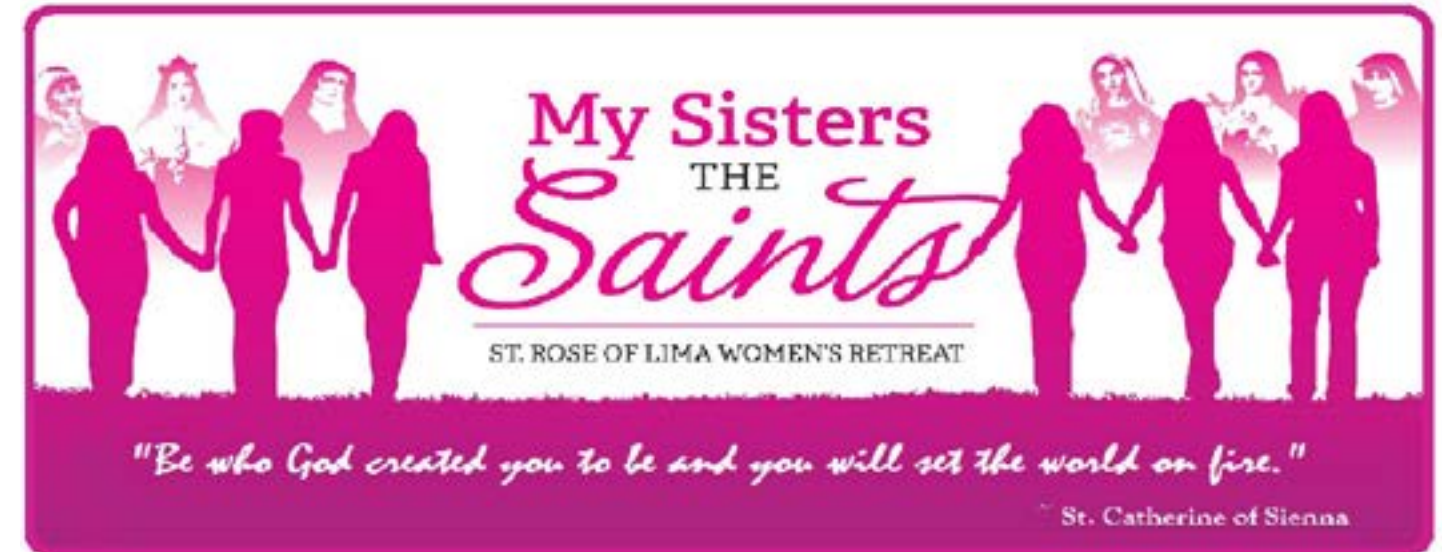
