Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

In today's gospel, we meet three different individuals who seek to follow Christ. Jesus rebukes each of them, criticizing their commitment to the Gospel.

The First man claims dedication by saying, "I will follow you wherever you go." How often do we tell God or others that we will do what is right, but then fulfill our own pleasure instead? We have a tendency to build fantasies about what it means to do divine work and to fulfill our destinies but we lack the fortitude to actually accomplish our tasks when they become difficult.

The second man responds to Jesus' call to follow him by telling Jesus he wants to bury his father—not because his father had died or was sick and going to die, but because he did not want to follow Jesus right now. The Man wanted to do his own thing first or wait until the time when following Jesus was more convenient. However, there is never a perfect time to follow the Creator's design for us. If we are not willing to follow the Father's invitation to fulfill our destiny now, there is no assurance that we will choose to follow the Lord later.

The last man asks to say farewell to his family at home, indicating a desire to look to his past before going with Christ. If we are not focused on what Christ lays before us proceeding into the future (rather we are longing for what was) we are not able to fulfill God's plan.

Discipleship is about putting Christ at the center of all things, giving us the ability to live our lives according the Creator's divine plan. All of humanity is called to this divine truth and to walk the path of Christ.

Decimotercero Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

En el Evangelio de hoy, conocemos a tres personas diferentes que buscan seguir a Cristo. Jesus reprende a cada uno de ellos, criticando su compromiso a la palabra de Dios.

El primer individuo pretende tener dedicación al decir "Te seguiré a dondequiera que vayas." ¿Cuántas veces le decimos a Dios o a los demás que haremos lo correcto, pero en vez de eso caemos en satisfacer nuestros propios deseos? Tendemos a hacernos fantasías acerca de obrar de manera divina y cumplir con nuestro destino, pero carecemos de la fortaleza necesaria para realmente lograr esa tarea cuando las cosas se ponen difíciles.

El segundo individuo responde a la llamada de Jesus a seguirlo diciéndole que quiere enterrar primero a su padre, no porque el padre haya muerto o esté enfermo y agonizando, sino porque en ese momento todavía no desea seguir a Jesus. El hombre quería hacer lo suyo primero y esperar a seguir a Jesus cuando le fuera más conveniente. Sin embargo, no hay tiempo perfecto para seguir el camino que el Creador ha diseñado para nosotros. Si no estamos dispuestos a aceptar la invitación del Padre para cumplir con nuestro destino ahora mismo, nadie nos puede asegurar que más adelante optaremos por seguir al Señor.

El último hombre pide primero despedirse de su familia en su hogar, indicando un deseo de mirar a su pasado antes de seguir a Cristo. Si no nos enfocamos en lo que Cristo nos pone enfrente antes de dar paso al futuro (y preferimos anhelar el pasado), no podemos cumplir con el plan de Dios.

Nuestro discipulado se trata de poner a Cristo al centro de todas las cosas, dándonos la capacidad de vivir nuestras vidas de acuerdo al plan divino del Creador. Toda la humanidad es llamada a esta verdad divina, de caminar el camino hacia Cristo.

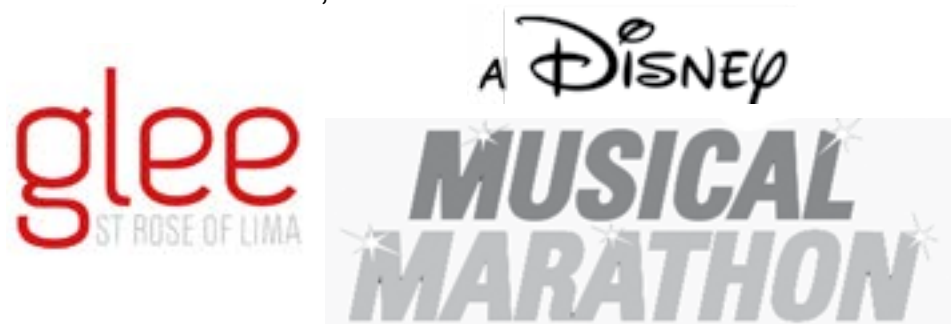

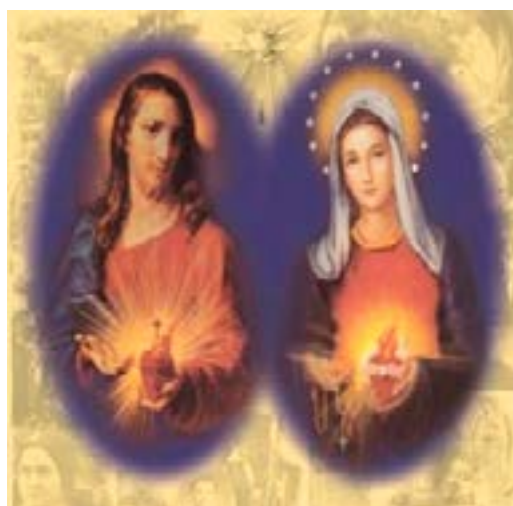
Ministries, Groups & Organizations
