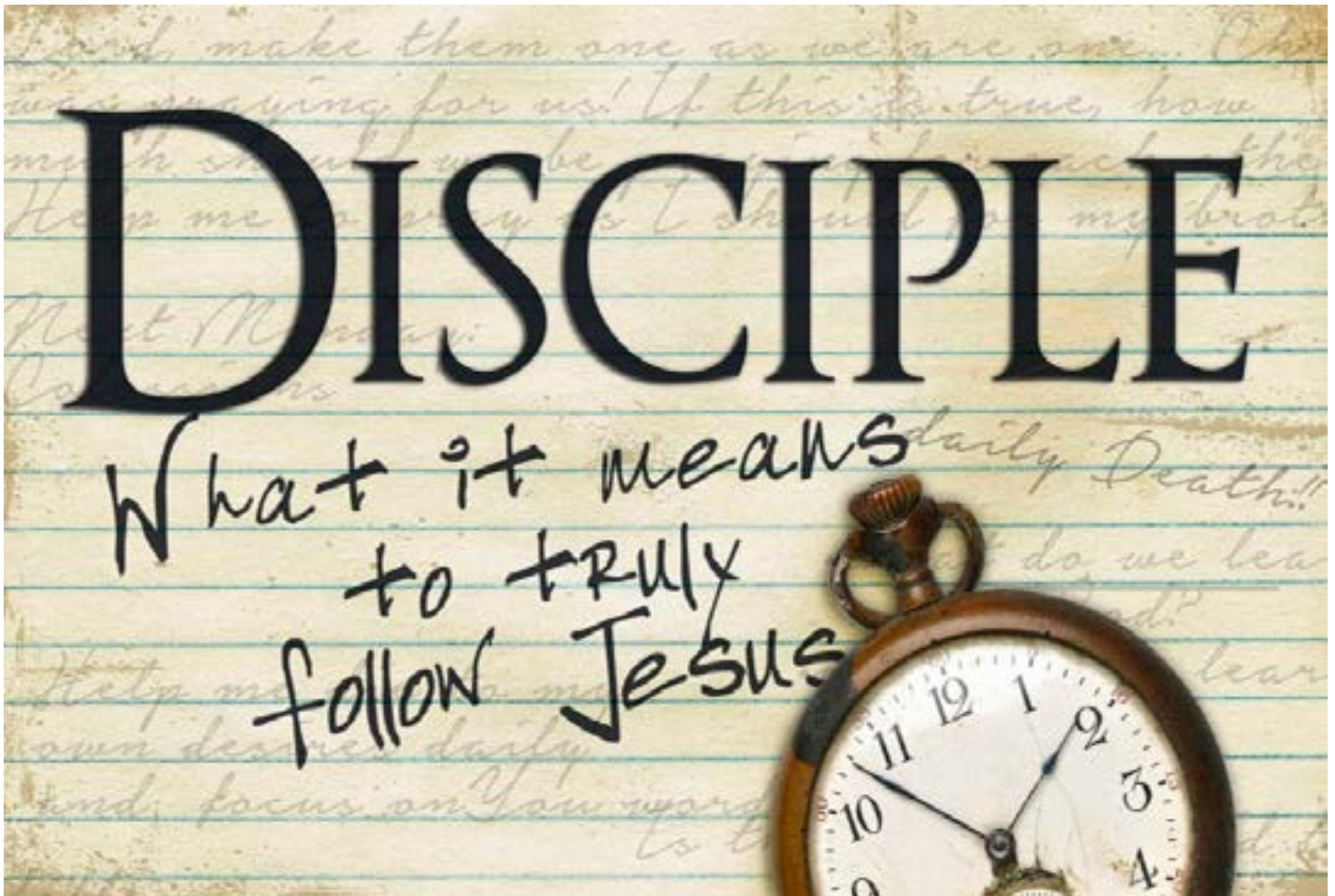

Twenty-Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

Jesus describes to us in a practical way what a faithful commitment to God means. A builder or a king will assess the resources or strength needed to accomplish their goals of building a tower or obtaining victory. They will proceed in action according to their capability. Anyone not making such judgments before beginning a task is a fool. The Father sends Jesus into the world to suffer and die on the cross, and to give life through the resurrection so that the Paschal Mystery would become God's victory over sin and evil. The victory has already been won. What is in question does not relate to the Lord's success: It is *our* victory which is yet to be determined.

Although the Lord is victorious, the choice is given to each one of us on whether we will join in Christ's victory or not. Have we calculated the cost and challenge of eternal life? It is impossible to have enough resources, money, or strength to gain eternity on our own. To seek life from a material existence is a fool's errand because the physical universe is not eternal. The only way we can have true life is through the Paschal Mystery, the victory in Christ. The true life of eternity comes from understanding and living the way of Christ, which is the cross. Jesus renounced all his possessions—even his life—so as to show the Father's commitment to us and to fulfill humanity's commitment to God. Christ does what is asked of us. The last piece of the puzzle is whether you and I will do the same.

Consider "Pascal's Wager"; the argument that it's best for a person to act as if God exists, since the possibility of eternal punishment in hell outweighs any advantage of believing otherwise. Pascal, a mathematician from the 1600's, proposed that if God does not exist, then you will neither gain nor lose anything from your commitment or noncommitment because nothing exists after death. On the other hand, if God does exist and you are committed to Him, you'll receive your eternal reward. If God exists and you are *not* committed to Him, you will be separated from Him in Hell. There is everything to gain by committing ourselves to Christ, and everything thing to lose by not. The risk is too high to *not* choose faith in Christ!

Vigésimo Primero Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Jesús nos describe de un modo práctico lo que es el compromiso fiel a Dios. Un constructor o un rey evaluarían los recursos o fuerzas necesarias para lograr las metas para edificar una torre u obtener la victoria. Se originaría una acción conforme a su capacidad. Cualquiera que no haga tales juicios antes de comenzar una tarea es un ingenuo, ¿verdad? Dios no es un ingenuo ¿cierto? Porque a Dios no se le puede engañar, el Padre envió a Jesús al mundo a sufrir, a morir por nosotros en la cruz y a darnos vida por medio de su resurrección de manera que, el Misterio Pascual se convertiría en la victoria de Dios sobre el pecado y el mal. La victoria ya ha sido ganada. Lo que esta en cuestión no se refiere al éxito de Nuestro Señor; más bien, es nuestra victoria que aún está por ser definida.

Aunque Nuestro Señor es victorioso, la elección de elegir a sido otorgada a cada uno de nosotros de, si vamos o no, a participar en la victoria y la celebración de Cristo. Acaso hemos calculado el costo y el desafío de la vida eterna, nuestra salvación. Para que nosotros logremos alcanzar esta meta, es imposible tener los suficientes recursos, dinero o fuerzas para adquirir la eternidad por nosotros mismos o el mundo. Buscar la vida de una existencia material es engaño del tonto porque, el universo físico no es eterno. – Nadie puede dar lo que no tiene. – En el único camino que podemos tener vida verdadera es por medio del Misterio Pascual, la victoria de Cristo. La verdadera vida eterna proviene de entender y vivir el camino de Cristo, que es la cruz. Jesús "renunció a todos sus bienes" hasta de su vida misma, con el fin de mostrar el compromiso que el Padre con nosotros y con la humanidad. La última pieza del rompecabezas es, si nosotros hacemos lo mismo.

Si no son capaces de confiar completamente en Jesús con el fin de "renunciar a todo" por el Padre, consideren calcular el costo de elegir o no, tener un compromiso fiel. Pascual, un matemático del los 1600, propuso que si uno elige tener un compromiso con Cristo, entonces existen dos posibles resultados. En primer lugar, hay un Dios que se preocupa y reciba el premio de la vida eterna. En segundo lugar, no hay un Dios o a Dios no le importa, en lo que resulta una vida vivida en fe y nada existe después de la muerte. Pascual también señaló que, si uno elige no comprometerse con Cristo existen dos posibilidades adicionales. En primer lugar, existe un Dios que se preocupa por lo que, no recibe una recompensa eterna y por lo tanto seria separado de Dios por toda la eternidad, a lo que comúnmente se le llama infierno. En segundo lugar, no hay Dios, o Dios no se preocupa por la fe ni por lo que se vive en una vida y no existe después de la muerte. En conclusión, para contar el costo, hay mucho que ganar al comprometernos con Cristo y todo lo que hay que perder si no. El riesgo es demasiado alto como para no optar por la fe en Cristo!
